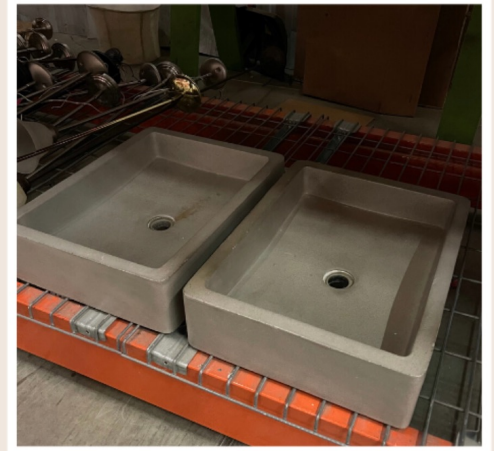
SLIM SHADY
