Building Homes, Building Hope



- Broke ground on 6 new homes, marking the start of life-changing journeys for future homeowners.
- Dedicated 4 homes to families, celebrating their achievement of homeownership.
- **Completed 8 critical home repairs** for low-income homeowners, ensuring safe and stable living environments.

Empowering Families Through Financial Education



- Served **10 households** with our life-transforming financial education program, equipping participants with tools for long-term financial stability.
